This position works as part of the seasonal crew to help implement the integrated weed and pest management programs conducted by HSCWP. Tasks include:

- spraying weeds and conducting mechanical weed treatments
- collecting and reporting daily treatment data using GIS/GPS technology
- assisting with mosquito surveys and treatments
- helping to maintain all equipment used by the district
- assisting the office manager with chemical sales

Employees are required to:

- possess a valid driver's license and be insurable by the district carrier
- handle and use pesticides
- wear long sleeved shirts, long pants, gloves, closed toed shoes and socks, head protection and any other personal protective equipment as required by pesticide labels
- have the ability to carry up to 50lbs while walking in rough terrain
- be able to read and follow pesticide label directions

An ideal candidate will have the ability to work as part of a team, be willing to accept direction from a supervisor, and be able to work with the public. Strong communication, computer and writing skills are also necessary. Experience operating a 4-wheel drive vehicle with a standard transmission, ATVs/UTVs and pulling a trailer is also desirable.

This position is forty hours per week with the opportunity for approved overtime; the schedule is assigned by the District Supervisor and may include irregular hours. It includes outdoor work with strenuous physical activity in inclement weather and some office/shop work depending on project needs. Training in the safe handling and use of pesticides will be provided.
